### IMPORTANT COURSE SPECIFIC ENROLMENT ADVICE

Students are expected to enrol as per the standard structure outlined on this Course Summary Sheet, and are responsible for ensuring their unit selection is correct. Failure to do so may result in financial and academic penalties.

**Underloads** – it is not expected that a student should underload – i.e undertake less credit points than the standard semester load. If, however, your circumstances require you to undertake less units than the standard load, it may lead to difficulties in undertaking units in a timely manner later in the course.

**Overloads** – it is not expected that a student should overload – i.e undertake more credit points than the standard semester load. If, however, your circumstances require you to overload you should be aware of the possible academic consequences of an increased study load.

**Course Progression** – students should attempt to follow the standard course progression as outlined on the Course Summary Sheet. Failure to do so could result in difficulties in unit selection. It is a student's responsibility to ensure they have met pre-requisite and co-requisite requirements when they select their enrolment program. Students should enrol in **each** semester of Masters enrolment. At the end of each semester your result in the unit will show as 'T' - Assessment Continues, if progress is satisfactory. A final grade of S (Satisfactory) will be given once the thesis has been examined according to the degree rules.

#### **Compulsory Coursework Units**

All students will be required to complete EDN611 Professional Applications of Research and EDN612 Conducting Innovative Educational Research, unless they are able to show that they have completed the equivalent study and are given an exemption by the course coordinator. Grades are awarded for these units.

#### **Class codes**

When completing your enrolment form you will be required to indicate the **class code** for each unit that you will be studying. The class code indicates the manner in which you are studying the unit. The class codes for each unit and an explanation are listed below:

**INT** The unit is taught on the Kelvin Grove campus
