### Class Codes

When completing your enrolment form you will be required to indicate the **class code** for each unit you will be studying in 2009. **I-NET** The unit will be conducted through the QUT Blackboard web site. Access to suitable computer facilities with a minimum equivalent of a Pentium 3 processor, 56K modem and Internet Access.

### **BACHELOR OF EARLY CHILDHOOD - ED44 – COMPLETION OF 4<sup>TH</sup> YEAR OF STUDY**

Students will need to apply for re-admission to the ED93 Bachelor of Education (Preservice) Early childhood course in order to become registered as a teacher in Queensland. If you wish to re-admit to the ED93 course, please contact the Administration Officers above, for advice on credit and the units you will need to complete. The ED93 course requires successful completion of three x 20-day Block Practical units in order to be registered by the Queensland College of Teachers.

### **COURSE RULES**

**Students are expected to enrol as per the standard structure outlined on this Course Summary Sheet, and are responsible for ensuring their unit selection is correct. Failure to do so may result in financial and academic penalties.**

**External Mode** (Unit Class Code I-NET) External study involves accessing course materials online and participating in the interactive, online teaching activities prepared for you on the QUT Blackboard web site.

**Normal enrolment load:** 24 credit points per semester

**Underloads:** Students may underload their enrolment to one unit (12 credit points) without formal approval.

**Overloads:** Students may overload their enrolment to four units (48 credit points) without formal approval.

**Failure of Units:** Students should be aware that failure of units may result in problems with course progression. It is the student's responsibility to redeem the failed grade(s) in a manner compatible with unit availability and field experience requirements.

**Maximum time limit:** 10 years.

**Limits on grades of 3:** A new policy concerning grades of 3 comes into effect from 1 January 2009 (QUT MOPP C/9.2). With effect from this date grades of 3 will no longer be considered a conceded or low pass but will be classified as a fail grade. Any grades of 3 awarded prior to 1 January 2009 will retain the conceded pass status and will be counted for graduation purposes up to the maximum number of grades of 3 permitted for your course.
