Class Codes

When completing your online enrolment you will be required to indicate the **class code** for each unit that you will be studying in 2009. The class code indicates the manner in which you are studying the unit. Please note that ED51 is an internal course and a unit cannot be taken in an alternative mode unless you have Program Coordinator approval or Faculty of Education approval. Class codes noted on the Course Summary Sheet are indicated as follows:

INTERNAL (INT)

Unit is taught on the Kelvin Grove campus.

EXTERNAL (EXT/EXTN)

External study involved accessing course materials online and participating in the interactive, online learning and teaching activities prepared for you on each unit's Online Learning and Teaching (OLT) website.

BLOCK (BLK)

Students attend on campus for the days specified and complete the assessment throughout the semester of offering.

INTERNET (I-NET)

The unit will be conducted through the Online Learning and Teaching (OLT) site.

Minimum Requirement: Access to suitable computer facilities with a minimum equivalent of a Pentium 3 processor, 56K modem and Internet Access.

EXTERNAL STUDY

Students are permitted to study in external mode, only if approved to do so by the ED51 Program Coordinator or by the Course Administration Officer.

BACHELOR OF GENERAL STUDIES (EDUCATION) ED45

Students have the option to exit ED51 early with a three-year ED45 Bachelor of General Studies. Students wishing to take up this option should complete and lodge an SRX Form on nearing completion of the sixth semester of study, requesting that they be transferred to ED45 Bachelor of General Studies.

Students will need to have successfully completed 288 credit points of study comprising 96 credit points of specified education studies including 48 credit points of advanced level units; 96 credit points of Discipline/Content Studies, with the remaining 96 credit points taken from those on offer in the course or from studies approved in advance by the Program Coordinator. A minimum of 48 credit points must be undertaken at the advanced level. There is no direct entry to ED45. Graduates of this degree are *not eligible* for teacher registration in Queensland. Students wishing to take this exit option should contact the Course Administration Officer for advice.

IMPORTANT COURSE SPECIFIC ENROLMENT ADVICE

Course Information: ED51 is accredited as a full-time, internal course. Students are not permitted to undertake units in external mode unless advised to do so by the Program Coordinator or by the Faculty of Education.

Students are responsible for ensuring that their unit selection is correct. Failure to do so may result in financial and academic penalties.

Blue Card Requirement - Prior to commencing the Education units in this course you will be required to hold a valid Blue Card to enable you to complete the field studies requirements of the course. Blue Card applications may take up to 16 weeks to process and it is therefore essential that you ensure you submit your application for the card at least a semester before you are scheduled to undertake any field studies units.

If you do not hold a valid card at the commencement of the field studies or have not applied for a renewal within the required time frame, you will be unable to participate in the required activities and will need to be withdrawn from the unit(s). This may incur both financial and academic penalty depending on the date the application was submitted. The Faculty of Education reserves the right not to finalise field studies placements for students who fail to take appropriate action to ensure they have a current Blue Card authorized with QUT to cover every semester in which they have a Queensland-based field studies unit. Field Studies will be taken in Queensland schools.

Designated Units: At the end of each year students who have failed to achieve a satisfactory level of performance in a designated unit will be eligible for exclusion. Please refer to the unit outlines for more information and/or <http://www.studentservices.qut.edu.au/assess/performance/performance/designated/>

Underloads: If your circumstances require you to undertake fewer units than the standard load it may lead to difficulties in undertaking units in a timely manner later in the course. Students should also be aware of potential problems with Austudy if they choose to underload. The Faculty of Education permits students to underload to 36cp without Faculty approval.

Overloads: If you decide to overload you should be aware of the possible academic consequences of an increased study load. Students should also be aware of problems that may arise in the future with Austudy if they elect to overload. The Faculty of Education permits students to overload to 60 credit points (ie standard program plus one more unit) without Faculty approval only if their course grade point average is 4.0 or higher). Units undertaken in block mode count as units in the semester and the 60 credit points maximum load still applies.

Course Progression: Students should attempt to follow the standard course progression as outlined on the Course Summary Sheet. Failure to do so could result in difficulties in unit selection. Students are responsible for ensuring that they have met pre-requisite and co-requisite requirements when they select their enrolment program (check QUT Handbook at www.handbook.qut.edu.au). In particular, students are to seek advice before submitting their placement form if they wish to take a practicum unit with units outside of the normal progression.

Failure of Units: Students should be aware that failure of units may result in problems with course progression. It is the student's responsibility to redeem the failed grade(s) in a manner compatible with unit availability and practicum requirements.

Limits on grades of 3 - A new policy concerning grades of 3 comes into effect from 1 January 2009 (QUT MOPP C/9.2). With effect from this date grades of 3 will no longer be considered a conceded or low pass but will be classified as a fail grade. Any grades of 3 awarded prior to 1 January 2009 will retain the conceded pass status and will be counted for graduation purposes up to the maximum number of grades of 3 permitted for your course. Grades of 3 incurred in units that commence after 1 January 2009 will not count towards your degree. The maximum number of pre-2009 grades of 3 permitted for this course can be found [here](#).

Students choosing the Middle Years Pathway will undertake the following units in Semester 8 of the program: EDB443 Professional Internship of Associate Teaching (no longer offered); SPB008 Middle Years Students and Schools; SPB022 Middle Years Curriculum, Pedagogy and Assessment; and EDB433 Primary Professional Practice 4: Beginning Teaching. Students have the option of choosing the Middle Years pathway which will enable them to have expertise in middle year schooling. The option involves choosing four units in the final semester including a practicum in the middle years setting.

Research Pathway Option (48 credit points)

Before the commencement of Year 3, students with a Grade Point Average of 5.5 or above will have been invited to undertake the Research Pathway option. This option is designed to meet the needs of students wishing to undertake research-based higher degree study in the course of their future career. The pathway is designed to develop research skills and a research-oriented, reflective approach to teaching. To accommodate the 48 credit points in the Research Pathway students will undertake one less Discipline Studies Elective unit (3 units instead of the usual 4 units) with the remaining 36 credit points of research pathway studies covered by the 2 Education elective units and 1 curriculum elective unit normally undertaken in the final semester of study. Students undertaking their final practicum in semester 2 should ensure that their second semester enrolment is finalised before the commencement of the practicum. Students should ensure that there are no timetable clashes with their selected program and amend if necessary.
