### Class Codes

The class codes appear after each unit in this Course Summary Sheet. An explanation of the class codes that are relevant to Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood) students is indicated below:

**INTERNAL (INT)** Unit is taught on the Kelvin Grove campus

**EXTERNAL (EXT or EXTN)** External study involved accessing course materials online and participating in the interactive, online learning and teaching activities prepared for you on each unit's Online Learning and Teaching (OLT) website.

Students should note that the ED52 Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood) course is approved as a full-time, internal course. Education Studies electives, usually undertaken in fourth year may be available externally and students may elect to enrol as external students for these units.

**BLOCK (BLK)** Up to five days of daily on-campus attendance with the assessment to be finalised throughout the semester.

**INTERNET (I-NET)** The unit will be conducted through the Online Learning and Teaching (OLT) site.

Minimum Requirement: Access to suitable computer facilities with a minimum equivalent of a Pentium 3 processor, 56K modem and Internet Access.

### Early Exit Options

Students have the option to exit ED52 early with a three-year ED45 Bachelor of General Studies or ED43 Bachelor of Early Childhood Studies. Students may apply to exit with ED43 Bachelor of Early Childhood Studies if they have successfully completed 288cps with 168cps in specific early childhood units. These 168 credit points must be comprised of units from the Curriculum Studies and Professional Practice areas in ED52 and the remaining 120cps from the Content/Discipline studies areas. The 14 Curriculum Studies and Professional Practice units must include EDB422 Early Childhood Professional Practice: Preschool and Kindergarten and EDB420 Early Childhood Professional Practice: Child Care or equivalent.

Students who do not meet this criteria may apply to exit with ED45 Bachelor of General Studies but will need to have successfully completed 288 credit points of study comprising 96 credit points of specified Education studies and 96 credit points of Discipline/Content Studies, with the remaining 96 credit points taken from those on offer in the course or from studies approved in advance by the Program Coordinator.

Students wishing to take up either option should complete and lodge an SRX Form on nearing completion of the sixth semester of study, requesting that they be transferred to the ED45 Bachelor of General Studies or ED43 Bachelor of Early Childhood Studies. There is no direct entry to ED45.

Alternatively students may apply to change to the three-year ED82 Bachelor of Early Childhood Studies by applying for direct entry using an Intra-Faculty Change Form (R/I Form) and applying for academic credit. Students should refer to the ED82 Course Summary Sheet for details of course structure and should be aware of academic credit threshold limits. Students are not permitted to take two exits from the one course. Graduates from ED43, ED45 and ED82 are **not eligible** for teacher registration in Queensland.

## **COURSE SPECIFIC RULES**

**Students are expected to enrol as per the standard structure outlined on this Course Summary Sheet, and are responsible for ensuring their unit selection is correct. Failure to do so may result in financial and academic penalties.**

**Blue Card Requirement:** Prior to commencing the Education units in this course you will be required to hold a valid Blue Card to enable you to complete the field studies requirements of the course. Blue Card applications may take up to 16 weeks to process and it is therefore essential that you ensure you submit your application for the card at least a semester before you are scheduled to undertake any field studies units.

If you do not hold a valid card at the commencement of the field studies or you have not applied for a renewal within the required time frame, or do not have your card registered with QUT, you will be unable to participate in the required activities and will need to be withdrawn from the unit(s). This may incur both financial and academic penalty depending on the date the application was submitted. The Faculty of Education reserves the right not to finalise field studies placements for students who fail to take appropriate action to ensure they have a current Blue Card authorized with QUT to cover every semester in which they have a Queensland-based Field Studies unit. Field Studies will be taken in Queensland schools.

**Designated Units:** At the end of each year students who have failed to achieve a satisfactory level of performance in a designated unit will be eligible for exclusion. Please refer to the unit outlines for more information and/or <http://www.studentservices.qut.edu.au/assess/other/performance/designated/>

**Course Information:** ED52 Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood) is accredited as a full-time, internal course. Students are not permitted to undertake units in a mode without Faculty approval. Approval can be sought in writing from the Course Administration Officer or Program Coordinator. Supporting documentation is required.

**Overload:** It is not expected that a student should overload - ie take more credit points than the standard semester load. If however, your circumstances require you to undertake more units than the standard load, you should be aware of the possible academic consequences of an increased study load. Students should also be aware of problems that may arise in the future with Austudy if they elect to overload. The Faculty of Education permits students to overload to 60 credit points (ie standard program plus one more unit) without Faculty approval only if their course grade point average is 4.0 or higher.

**Underload:** It is not expected that a student should underload - ie take less credit points than the standard semester load. If however, your circumstances require you to undertake fewer units than the standard load, it may lead to difficulties in undertaking units in a timely manner later in the course. Students should also be aware of potential problems with Austudy if they choose to underload. The Faculty of Education permits students to underload to 36 cps without Faculty approval.

**Course Progression:** Students should follow the standard course progression as outlined in the Course Summary Sheet. Failure to do so will result in difficulties in semester unit selection and timetable clashes. Students are responsible for ensuring that they have met prerequisite and co-requisite requirements when they select their enrolment program. These are listed on unit outlines in QUT Virtual.

**Limits on grades of 3 -** A new policy concerning grades of 3 comes into effect from 1 January 2009 (QUT MOPP C/9.2). With effect from this date grades of 3 will no longer be considered a conceded or low pass but will be classified as a fail grade. Any grades of 3 awarded prior to 1 January 2009 will retain the conceded pass status and will be counted for graduation purposes up to the maximum number of grades of 3 permitted for your course. Grades of 3 incurred in units that commence after 1 January 2009 will not count towards your degree. The maximum number of pre-2009 grades of 3 permitted for this course can be found [here](#).

**Failure of Units:** Students should be aware that failure of units may result in problems with course progression. Students must redeem the failed grade(s), ie repeat failed units in a manner compatible with unit availability and field studies/practicum unit requirements.

**Maximum number of years in which to complete course:** Ten (10) years

Before the commencement of Year 3, students with a GPA of 5.5 or above will be invited to undertake the Research Pathway option. This option is designed to meet the needs of students wishing to undertake research-based higher degree study in the course of their future career. The pathway is designed to develop research skills and a research-oriented reflective approach to teaching.

To accommodate the 48cps in the Research Pathway, students will undertake one less Discipline Studies Elective unit (3 units instead of the usual 4) with the remaining 36cps of the Research Pathway covered by the 2 Education Studies Electives and 1 Curriculum Elective usually taken in the final semester of study.
