To be eligible for admission, an applicant must have:

- (i) Completed a three year undergraduate degree in human services or social work.
- (ii) Alternatively they must possess a non-human services three year undergraduate degree and be able to demonstrate employment experience in the community service industry or related occupations such as teaching, nursing or allied health, community development, psychology or law of at least one year's duration; and
- (iii) Achieved a GPA of 5 or equivalent in their degree; or
- (iv) Successful completion of a Graduate Diploma in Human Services
