### IMPORTANT COURSE SPECIFIC ENROLMENT ADVICE

Students are expected to enrol as per the standard structure outlined on this Course Summary Sheet, and are responsible for ensuring their unit selection is correct. Failure to do so may result in financial and academic penalties.

**Underloads** – it is not expected that a student should underload – i.e. undertake less credit points than the standard semester load. If, however, your circumstances require you to undertake less units than the standard load, it may lead to difficulties in undertaking units in a timely manner later in the course.

**Overloads** – it is not expected that a student should overload – i.e. undertake more credit points than the standard semester load. If, however, your circumstances require you to overload you should be aware of the possible academic consequences of an increased study load. A GPA greater than 4 is required to undertake an overload. Please consult the Course Coordinator.

**Course Progression** – students should attempt to follow the standard course progression as outlined on the Course Summary Sheet. Failure to do so could result in difficulties in unit selection. It is a student's responsibility to ensure they have met pre-requisite and co-requisite requirements when they select their enrolment program.

**Blue Card Requirement** - Prior to commencing the Education units in this course you will be required to hold a valid Blue Card and have that Blue Card registered with QUT to enable you to complete the Field Studies requirements. Blue Card applications may take up to 16 weeks to process and it is therefore essential that you ensure you submit your application for the card at least a semester before you are scheduled to undertake any Field Studies units. If you do not hold a valid card registered through a QUT Student Centre at the commencement of the Field Studies you will be unable to participate in the required activities and will need to be withdrawn from the unit(s). This may incur both financial and academic penalty depending on the date the application was submitted. **Field Studies** - you should be aware that 5 periods of field experience, each of 4 continuous weeks duration, occur through the program. Each field experience requires your full-time attendance at a school or other educational institution at the programmed time. You should plan ahead to ensure that work and other events and commitments do not impinge on your field experiences. Also note that it is not possible to study discipline units in semesters that include field studies unless the combination is incorporated in the standard course progression. **Designated Units** – Field Studies units are also designated units which students are required to complete in order to continue with their award course. Student performance in these units is reviewed at the end of each year. Students who do not successfully complete the practicum requirements of these units will have their progress in the course reviewed.

**Internship** - you are required to undertake an Internship unit as the final unit of study in this course. Permission to undertake this internship must be granted by the Queensland College of Teachers (QCT). This can only be granted if you have successfully completed **all** other course requirements by the end of year 4 semester 1 and have only the units listed on the CSS for Year 4 semester 2 to complete. If you have units other than those listed on the CSS for Year 4 semester 2, you are not eligible to undertake the Internship and your enrolment in the unit will be cancelled. Please seek course progression advice if this is the case.

**Maximum Number of Grades of Three:** 4\*                      **Maximum Time to Complete Degree:** 11 years  
(\* with a maximum of three Grades of 3 in either the discipline or education component)

*A new policy concerning grades of 3 comes into effect from 1 January 2009 (QUT MOPP C/9.2). With effect from this date grades of 3 will no longer be considered a conceded or low pass but will be classified as a fail grade. Any grades of 3 awarded prior to 1 January 2009 will retain the conceded pass status and will be counted for graduation purposes up to the maximum number of grades of 3 permitted for your course. ### **Cooperative Education Program**

An optional one-year period of paid work experience is available to eligible full-time students. Students participating in this program enrol in INB300 Professional Practice in IT in the first semester of the program and in INB302 IT Capstone Project in the second semester of the program. The cooperative education program and its mentoring and assessment requirements make up the required contact and assessment components of both units. Eligibility criteria apply. International students are not eligible due to visa restrictions.

Part-time students who are working in a professional IT position may be able to use their current employment to meet the criteria for completing INB300 Professional Practice in IT, after completion of 168 credit points in the Bachelor of Information Technology, subject to meeting eligibility criteria.
