IFN101 Full-time Masters' research (extension) 48 credit points

#### Part-time students:

Students enrol each semester in either:

IFN200 Part-time Masters' research 24 credit points

*or*, in instances where a candidate has exceeded the normal course duration and an extension of time has been approved:

IFN201 Part-time Masters' research (extension) 24 credit points
