Course Notes

- *Change of Attendance Mode:* Students wishing to change attendance mode from internal to external **must** do so in writing to the Senior Administration Officer (Undergraduate Programs) prior to the commencement of semester. Applications received after this time will not normally be considered.
- Students should not normally enrol in elective units until the equivalent of 192 credit points has been completed.
- Students may only undertake a maximum of 48 credit points of non-law elective units.
- On-line enrolment programs may be subject to Law School approval.

- Students deviating from the normal course structure may experience difficulties with the class timetable and the examination timetable.

Transitional arrangements for Law units:

- If you have completed LWB138 Fundamentals of Torts but not LWB139 Select Issues in Torts you must undertake LWB139 in semester one 2009.
- If you have completed LWB236 Real Property A but not LWB237 Real Property B or LWB332 Commercial and Personal Property Law you must undertake LWB332 in semester one 2009 and LWB244 Property Law B in second semester 2009.
- If you have completed LWB231 Introduction to Public Law and not LWB235 Australian Federal Constitutional Law you must undertake LWB242 Constitutional Law in 2009.
- Students must undertake LWB435 Legal Research in Practice in lieu of LWB434 Advanced Research and Legal Reasoning.

Limits on grades of 3: A new policy concerning grades of 3 comes into effect from 1 January 2009 (QUT MOPP C/9.2). With effect from this date grades of 3 will no longer be considered a conceded or low pass but will be classified as a fail grade. Any grades of 3 awarded prior to 1 January 2009 will retain the conceded pass status and will be counted for graduation purposes up to the maximum number of grades of 3 permitted for your course.
