^a Applicants with between one-quarter and three-quarters of the work undertaken is assessed on an ungraded basis (ie pass/fail, competent/not yet competent, satisfactory/not satisfactory or similar), the higher rank from this graded or the graded AQF diploma supplementary table may be used.^b

Applicants with less than one-quarter of the work undertaken is assessed on graded basis (ie pass/fail, competent/not yet competent, satisfactory/not satisfactory or similar) will be allocated a rank of the basis of AQF diploma ungraded supplementary table.^b

^b If any ungraded unit attempt, which has not been subsequently been successfully completed (ie ungraded pass, competent, satisfactory or similar), and/or any failed graded unit attempt exists only the grade-point average, this table will be used; regardless of other caveats.

^c RATE diplomas (e.g. those issue by Colleges of Advanced Education) are assessed on the ungraded or graded AQF advanced diploma or associate degree supplementary table.
